Smart Money Bonuses may be available for individuals who earn credentials.

Credentials document successful completion of a specific body of content knowledge.

The Center for Child Care Career Development awards three levels of credentials as a way to promote career development for those who educate and care for children in our state. Individuals may enroll at their local technical/community college to take the coursework.

All courses must have been taken since 2001 at one of the 16 technical/community colleges in South Carolina to earn any Early Childhood credential.

# To receive a Credential, submit both:

• A copy of your unofficial transcript for the required class or classes, AND...

• Credential Form found under Credentials on the website: www.sc-ccccd.net to the Center for Child Care Career Development.

You do not have to work in child care to receive a credential.

# SC Early Childhood Credential

This credential is awarded for successful completion of the 3-credit hour introductory course, Early Childhood Development 101, (ECD 101), at one of the 16 technical/ community colleges in South Carolina. This specially designed course serves as the foundation for Level 2 and Level 3 Credentials.

#### REQUIREMENT

#### ECD 101 Introduction to Early Childhood

If you have completed ECD 101 (in 2001 or later) with a grade of "C" or higher, you are eligible to receive the SC Early Childhood Credential and pin.

#### **School Age Credential**

This credential is awarded for successful completion of the 3-credit hour introductory course in out-of-school time care at one of the 16 technical/community colleges in the state.

# SAC 101 Best Practices in School Age and Youth Care Skills

If you have completed SAC 101 with a grade of "C" or higher, you are eligible to receive the SC School Age Credential and pin.
