SUBJECT: Reimbursement rates

As with the income eligibility guidelines the reimbursement rates are subject to change every year. This being the case, enclosed you will find the reimbursement rates and a current reimbursement worksheet for the period of **July 1, 2019** to **June 30, 2020**.

The paid rate for breakfast did not change from 2018-2019; the reduced rate for breakfast reflects a 5 cent increase from 2018-2019; and the free rate for breakfast reflects a 5 cent increase from 2018-2019.

The paid rate for lunch or supper reflects a 1 cent increase from 2018-2019; the reduced rate for lunch or supper reflects a 10 cent increase over 2018-2019; and the free rate for lunch or supper also reflects a 10 cent increase over 2018-2019.

The paid rate for snack did not change from 2018-2019; the reduced rate for snack reflects a 2 cent increase over 2018-2019; and the free rate for snack reflects a 3 cents increase over 2018-2019.

The cash-in-lieu increased from \$.2350 to \$.2375.

The reimbursement rates for Tier I child care homes increased by 2 cents for breakfast; 3 cents for lunch and supper and 1 cent for snacks; The reimbursement rates for Tier II child care homes were not changed for breakfast; increased by 2 cents for lunch and supper and were not changed for snacks. The changes in the administrative reimbursement rates for sponsoring organizations of child care homes reflect a 1.79 percent increase.
