FNS waives, for all CACFP sponsoring organizations that CACFP monitoring requirements included at 7 CFF 226.16(d)(4)(iii) be conducted onsite. Sponsoring organizations should continue monitoring activities of Program operations offsite (e.g., through desk audit).

This waiver extends the Nationwide Waiver of Monitoring Requirements for Sponsors in the Child and Adult Care Food Program granted on August 4, 2020 that expires on September 30, 2021. Consistent with section 2202(a)(2) of the Act, this waiver applies automatically to all sponsoring organizations that elect to use it and remains in effect until 30 days after the end of the public health emergency.
