Certification Regarding Suspension, Disbarment or Otherwise Excluded From Receiving Federal Funds

Institutions approved to participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program are considered subrecipients of federal funds. As the state administering agency, South Carolina Department of Social Services (SCDSS) is considered the recipient of the funds and the *pass-through-entity*. In accordance with the requirements of 2 CFR § 200.332, SCDSS is required to verify that institutions applying for participation in the CACFP are not excluded or disqualified from receiving federal funds. To accomplish this verification, we are requiring institutions to certify that the institution is not suspended, disbarred, or otherwise excluded from receiving federal funds.
